Purpose: This meeting aims to present information about the proposed allocation of funds and collect public input and feedback on the proposal.

Project Locations: 70 E McMicken Ave (includes 70-80 E McMicken Ave and 1705 Lang St)

Project Summary: This project is being renovated by Preservation of Affordable Housing (POAH) and Model Group. This is a \$26 Million LIHTC (Low Income Housing Tax Credit) rehabilitation project located within the West End, Over-the-Rhine and Mt. Auburn neighborhoods. The **overall project** will consist of 13 building renovations of 60 residential units and 5 commercial spaces. The multi-family units will serve affordable housing for seniors, families, individuals and households with disabilities with incomes at 60% Average Median Income or less. The 60 renovated units will consist of 16 one-bedrooms (\$662-\$937), 27 two-bedrooms (\$933-\$1,128), 13 three-bedrooms (\$843-\$1,502), 4 four-bedrooms (\$1,112-\$1,505). All 60 units will receive a rental subsidy through the two separate 20-year Housing Assistance Payment contracts. The developer plans to begin renovations early fall of 2026. The Department of Community & Economic Development is proposing a 15-year, net 67% Community Reinvestment Area (CRA) tax exemption and recommends up to \$1.85 million in direct financial assistance from the Downtown Over-the-Rhine East Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District for affordable housing set-a-side. **The affordable set aside TIF funds will only be used to renovate the buildings within the Over-The-Rhine East and Downtown District.**
