

GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS Old River Station Historical Tour

First Saturday of every month from 9:30 a.m. to noon. Reservations must be made at least one week in advance at <u>Tours.myGCWW.org</u>.

We're excited you've chosen to take a tour of the Old River Station of Greater Cincinnati Water Works (GCWW) at the Richard Miller Treatment Plant (RMTP)!

Your tour will include the following:

- The pump house and its history, beginning at ground level before the structure was lowered by hand to 105 feet below grade.
- The engine house, which is the boiler house that supplied steam to the engines, along with the coal storage area and riverside coal handling dock.
- The pump pit floor where you will stand among the four engines as they rest on 20-foot-thick wood caisson, six feet under the floor of the Ohio River.
- The great pump chamber that moved a staggering 30,000,000 gallons of water every day for 57 years.

Directions

RMTP is located at 5651 Kellogg Avenue, Cincinnati, OH 45230.

- From 1-275, take Kellogg Avenue Exit 72 and follow the signs for S.R. 52/Kellogg Avenue West.
- 2. Go approximately 1 mile.
- 3. Turn left into the GCWW main entrance and check in with the guard located at the entry gate.
- 4. Be sure to have all photo IDs ready.

Arrival

- Please arrive 10 minutes early.
- Tour begins promptly at 9:30 a.m.

Requirements

Waiver

Children are not permitted on this tour. All participants must be 8 or older. All participants <u>must complete a waiver</u>.

Photo ID

This is a secure and active facility. Participants must have a photo ID to present at the guarded entrance gate.

Attire

- Closed-toe and closed-heel shoes required. No sandals, flip-flops, or Croc-type shoes are permitted.
- Long pants are recommended (shorts are permitted when temperatures are high).
 Please note: There is no AC or heat in some areas. Indoor temperatures average between 55°F (winter) and 85°F (summer).



Accessibility

This is a walking tour with stairs and small obstacles. This is not an accessible facility; however, some parts of the tour can be accessed. Please advise us in advance if any of your party have mobility issues.

Safety

- Participants do NOT need hard hats or safety glasses.
- Please inform us ahead of time if anyone in your party has a fear of heights, confined spaces, easily becomes light-headed, or has vertigo.
- Smoking is NOT permitted inside the facility.
